**M.W. Bro. Paul E. Todd
Grand Master
The Grand Lodge of Canada
in the Province of Ontario**

R.W. Bro. Paul E. Todd was born in Belleville, Ontario and grew up in Trenton, Ontario and graduated from Trenton High School.

In Ottawa, he began working as an apprentice Mechanic obtaining his Class A license and also joined the Ontario Provincial Police Auxiliary Unit, retiring with the rank of Corporal.

Paul joined the Township of Nepean Fire Department in 1971, which is now part of the Ottawa Fire Services. The Governor General awarded him, The Federal Fire Service Medal for Exemplary Service and the Ontario Fire Marshall awarded him the Ontario Fire Marshall Long Service Medal. He retired 2002 after thirty-one years of Service.

He also worked part-time for Ontario Ambulance in Carleton Place Ontario leaving this position after 10 years of Service.

Paul joined Masonry on April 13, 1983 at St John's No. 63 Carleton Place, becoming the Master of St John's Lodge No. 63 in 1994-1995. . He was elected District Deputy Grand Master 1999-2000, for Ottawa District 1 and Master of Luxor Daylight Lodge No. 741 in Ottawa District No. 2.in 2003

Paul was the President of the Carleton Place Temple Corporation for five years, District Chairman of Blood Donors, Masonic Education for Ottawa District No. 1

Paul was appointed to the Board of General Purpose 2001, 2003 and 2005, and elected to the Board of General Purposes 2007, 2009.

In 2008 he was elected to the Management Committee of Grand Lodge and in 2009 he was re-elected for a three year term.

Paul retired from the Board of General Purposes in July of 2011 due to health issues and joined the Lodge of Instruction Team 2011 and was a presenter for two years.

Paul was a member of the Grand Lodge Masonic Education Committee, where he was the Team Leader responsible for the Masonic Education Newsletter, the Chairman of the Grand Lodge Committee of Long Range Planning, Grand Lodge Committee for the Condition of Masonry. Paul was then re-appointed to the Board of General Purposes and to the Management Committee as Liaison, while acting as Chairman of Condition of Masonry and was subsequently elected to the Management Committee for a three year term

Paul is the representative of the Grand Lodge of North Dakota, near the Grand Lodge of Canada in the Province of Ontario, a member of the Provincial Emergency Service Degree Team, was the Local Chairman of the Grand Lodge Committee for the International Plowing Match in Carleton Place and a Member of the Navan and Crosby IPM Committees.

Paul was a Member of the Grand Lodge 150th Anniversary committee as an actor in the play, the Grand Lodge Representative Amalgamation Committees in Ottawa, Cornwall, Kingston and Bath, a founding Director of the Masonic Chip Foundation, Co-Chair of the Local Committee on Arrangements for the Especial Communication of Grand Lodge in Ottawa and has chaired four Grand Master Receptions Committees for the Ottawa Districts.

In 2017 he became a member of the Royal Order of Scotland

He was elected Deputy Grand Master in July of 2015 and Grand Master in 2017

He was appointed a Director of the Masonic Foundation of Ontario for six years as Chairman responsible for the Web page and for approval of Masonic Foundation District projects

THE TOWERS

The land on which the Scottish Rite stands was part of the Crown Grant of land to Caleb Reynolds, U.E. on December 15, 1796. It was sold to Jean Baptiste Rousseaux, whose widow sold 500 acres in 1816 to James Mills and Peter Hess. James Mills settled on the 240 acres west of Queen Street and in or about 1835, he built Hamilton's first brick house on the site. In July 1884, Mr. Mills' estate sold the property to George T. Tuckett, son of George E. Tuckett, who had founded the Tuckett Tobacco Company and who served as Mayor of Hamilton in 1896.

In 1892, George T. Tuckett retained local architect James Balfour to design a residence for him on the property. It was completed in 1895. This building is now the Scottish Rite Club. Because of the typical "Balfouresque" architecture, the building was named "THE TOWERS". The iron fence was built ten years later. It is similar to the fence which surrounds Buckingham Palace in London, England.

The oak dining table in the Coffee Room is the original table made to order for George T. Tuckett. The woodwork in the Club, oak, bird's-eye maple, birch and cherry, was made in the furniture factory of John Hoodless & Sons, Hamilton.

In 1920, a group of Scottish Rite leaders in Hamilton bought it as a future home for the Scottish Rite in Hamilton. The cornerstone of the Cathedral was laid on May 31st, 1922, by M. Wor. Bro. W. N. Ponton, K.C., the Grand Master. The building was opened and dedicated on May 7th, 1923, by the Sovereign Grand Commander, Sir John M. Gibson, K. C. M. G.

On September 30, 2007, our Cathedral was dedicated to the honour and in the name of Ill. Bro. Norman E. Byrne, a Past Grand Master and Sovereign Grand Commander. A beautiful display case of his various regalia's now adorns the entranceway to the Cathedral.

Title to the property is held by a corporation entitled "TOWERS INC.", the corporation being owned by the three Scottish Rite Bodies which meet here.
